The significant impact of the RMHC Manitoba Mission is reflected in 5,311 total nights of accommodations and over \$1,307,000 in costly, out-of-pocket expenses saved by families.

RMHC Manitoba is guided by our values of compassion and care for all families, evolving to the needs of families, inclusivity, and operating with accountability and transparency. Guiding values and the increased needs of families confirmed RMHC Manitoba's steadfast commitment to expansion. Momentum and progress continued for the new Ronald McDonald House in 2019. With thanks to the incredible generosity of transformational and lead donors, ground-breaking is estimated for the late summer to fall of 2020.

RMHC Manitoba's 2019 success and impact was a result of our community stakeholders coming together united in generosity, support, and kindness. Because of donors' generous giving, families were close to the medical care their children needed, and families were together. Supporters provided necessary resources to help ensure accommodations and every essential of daily life was provided, leaving families the time, focus, and attention to support their sick children and each other. Providing an environment that feels like home is of the utmost importance for our Ronald McDonald House and Family Room. As families face one of the most challenging times, our two core programs provide much-needed support.

RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE[®]

Since **1984**, Ronald McDonald House Manitoba has provided a "home-awayfrom-home" for families with a child requiring medical treatment at a nearby hospital.

Families are referred to Ronald McDonald House by hospital staff who determine eligibility for rural Manitoba and out-of-province residents living **50** km or more from HSC Children's Hospital, HSC Women's Hospital, or St. Boniface Hospital. This allows families living a far distance away to have the comforts of home while remaining close to their child during their medical journey.

The **11,000** square foot house is located in close proximity to the hospital and supports **14** families at a time.



RONALD MCDONALD FAMILY ROOM[®]

Located on the third floor of HSC Children's Hospital since 2010, this 3,500 square foot space offers children receiving medical treatment, and their family members, a place to rest and relax in a home-like environment. The Family Room is a comfortable haven offering three on-site sleeping rooms, napping lounge, full kitchen, laundry facilities, showers, and living room, just steps away from pediatric medical care.

The Family Room welcomes and supports pediatric, neonatal, and emergency patients, and their families, who reside in Winnipeg, rural Manitoba, or out-of-province. Sleeping rooms are available to families whose child is in critical condition and requires the most urgent care. Hospital staff make sleeping room referrals to the Family Room, allowing families to remain together, just steps from their child's bedside.

"When we realized I was in preterm labour, we rushed to the Brandon hospital. We were soon informed that we would be moved to Winnipeg due to the complexity of my pregnancy.




33rd Annual Hope Couture Fashion Show




