

We were closely monitored, and during that time, we were introduced to the Ronald McDonald Family Room inside HSC Children's Hospital and Ronald McDonald House on Bannatyne Ave.

When you walk into the Family Room or House, you smell coffee, and everyone is so welcoming and supportive. We would go there to be together as a family, have a meal together, and play games. Through our journey, RMHC Manitoba has been there.


Karsen had his kidney transplant in 2018 and it has been a long journey. But we got

to know everyone at the Family Room and they felt like part of our family. It felt so comforting and they were such a support to us.

Without them, I don't know what we would have done. We would have been stuck in the 6 ft. by 6 ft. hospital room for days and days with no one to talk to. But the Family Room and House are set up to be like a house. They are more family-friendly and you have other people you can talk to who are going through the same things as you.

To have that support is huge. It feels like home and made our hospital stay so much better." - The Kehler family



RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE®

Since 1984, RMHC Manitoba's Ronald McDonald House has been a 'home-away-from-home' for families when they need it most.

Families from rural Manitoba or out-of-province residents who are eligible to stay with us are referred to stay at the House by hospital staff. The 11,000 square foot facility is located a short walk from Health Sciences Centre and supports up to 14 families at a time. The program provides welcoming accommodations, programming, services, and support to families requiring the medical care of pediatric health care centres including HSC Children's Hospital, HSC Women's Hospital, and St. Boniface Hospital.

Amenities offered to guest families include:

- Fully-equipped kitchens
- Lounge spaces
- Children's play areas
- Wi-Fi access
- Shower and washroom facilities
- Toiletries

- Wheelchair accessibilityFree laundry facilities

- Daily nutritious meals

RMHC Manitoba is proud to keep families close to the medical care their sick children require while alleviating the many potential financial burdens they may encounter when faced with the challenges of childhood illness or injury. In addition to this, families have access to compassionate support and essential resources while navigating their healing journey together.

RONALD MCDONALD FAMILY ROOM®

Operating since 2010, the Family Room provides a 'haven-within-the-hospital' on the third floor of HSC Children's Hospital.

The home-like environment offers 3,500 square feet of space for families to stay together just steps away from the essential care their children require. The program includes anapping lounge, full kitchen, laundry facilities, shower, and living room, which are available for all families with children receiving medical care from Winnipeg, rural Manitoba, or out-of-province. For families requiring the most critical care, three on-site sleeping rooms are available so they can be as close as possible to life-saving treatment for their child.

2021 was another inspiring and successful year for RMHC Manitoba.

The success was made possible by the generosity and continued support of our donors, partners, volunteers, and event sponsors. We maintained our commitment to continued and safe mission delivery, and achieved our strongest financial position to date.

Our financial year showed an annual gross revenue of \$12,514,361 which represents an increase of 212% compared to the prior year. Of the total revenue, \$10,376,009 was the capital campaign funds raised for the building of the new Ronald McDonald House.

Our annual fundraising events, the gala, golf tournament, and Champion for Families, were extremely successful. We are grateful to all who participated and gave generously.






